**Title: Learning Skills for Refugees and Immigrants with low or no educational background**

## **Project Description**

Humanitarian catastrophes prompt refugees and asylum-seekers to migrate to Europe. Language and communication barriers exacerbate this target group's settlement difficulties, which include locating affordable housing and employment. In their new community, they may encounter instances of prejudice and discrimination. Refugees and asylum seekers frequently face the consequences of interrupted education on schooling, resulting in a lack of English comprehension, few or no formal education-related skills, competencies, or experience.

In Europe, there is a dearth of research on exiles and migrants with a limited or nonexistent educational background in terms of adult education, knowledge acquisition, and additional skill training. The LEARN project aims to promote equal opportunity and access, as well as inclusion, diversity, and justice for the disadvantaged population. Organisations with limited resources and participants in need of educational tools tailored to the intended audience will be assisted and supplied with essential tools and materials.

## **Project Goals**

This initiative aims to guide refugees and migrants on how to begin their educational journey in their new country of residence.

It seeks to develop a comprehensive educational toolkit, including a structured training course, to facilitate refugees' adaptation to the national/European educational system. In addition, the objective is to provide high-quality learning opportunities that are tailored to the learning requirements of the target group, as well as an e-learning tool that will aid adult education centers and other organisations working towards the integration of refugees and migrants.
